- Current Cash Position: \$8,629.29; Projected Ending Cash Balance \$2,390.68
- Revenue Forecast \$49,251.50; Expense Forecast \$51,925; Net Loss (\$6,673.50)
- D.O.G.S:
 - No longer rolling up under PTC, money was moved to the new joint DOGs group
- Amazon smiles program is ending, no expected revenue going forward, historically was around \$600/year

- We manage money for Glenmart and Junior Naturalists - no longer have animals in the building due to allergies and air quality in the buildings. We can have animals in the building temporarily if it's related to our science unit.
